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Hall Rentals Requirements (Refer to “Social Gatherings/Gathering Limits” section of October 2, 2020 update for County Executive Orders of openings and closings in Anne Arundel County. Refer to items 32 – 38.

1. 25 Person Limit
2. Mask wearing mandate with hall interior and exterior signs
3. Social Distancing
4. Hall sanitizing-before and after
5. Rental agreement changes:
 - A. Release and Waiver with statement similar to “I am responsible for any insurance needs in case of any illness, harm or injury and that no such insurance is provided by Venice Civic Association.”
 - B. Remove “Self Clean” option and replace with “Hall Sanitization \$150”
 - C. Rental cannot occur any sooner than 1 week after prior rental
6. Event stoppage: “Should renter be in violation of these requirements the event can be immediately shut down.”

Other considerations:

Renter establishes a list of attendees in case there is a need for contact tracing

Renter can decide to use a Digital Infrared Thermometer for each person entering hall
