Thanks to all who have currently stepped up to run for the Board. We are making great progress but still need a few more spots filled--a few more of you great neighbors! Here is a description of all the positions. Please see where you fit in and get in touch!

President: Runs community meetings. Developing the agenda for all the meetings.  
The President is considered a member of any VCA committee(Ex Officio status).

Vice President: Steps in when the President is not available, for meetings or if the president leaves their position

Treasurer: Deposits all monies due the VCA. Special Community Benefit District(SCBD) tax accounting and reporting to the Anne Arundel county government. Responsible for organizing an independent audit, using non-officers and non-board members, every 4 years. Responsible for providing a report each meeting.

Board Members are responsible for attending each VCA meeting, as well as volunteering time when possible to community events ie. beach cleanup, labor day cookout etc.
